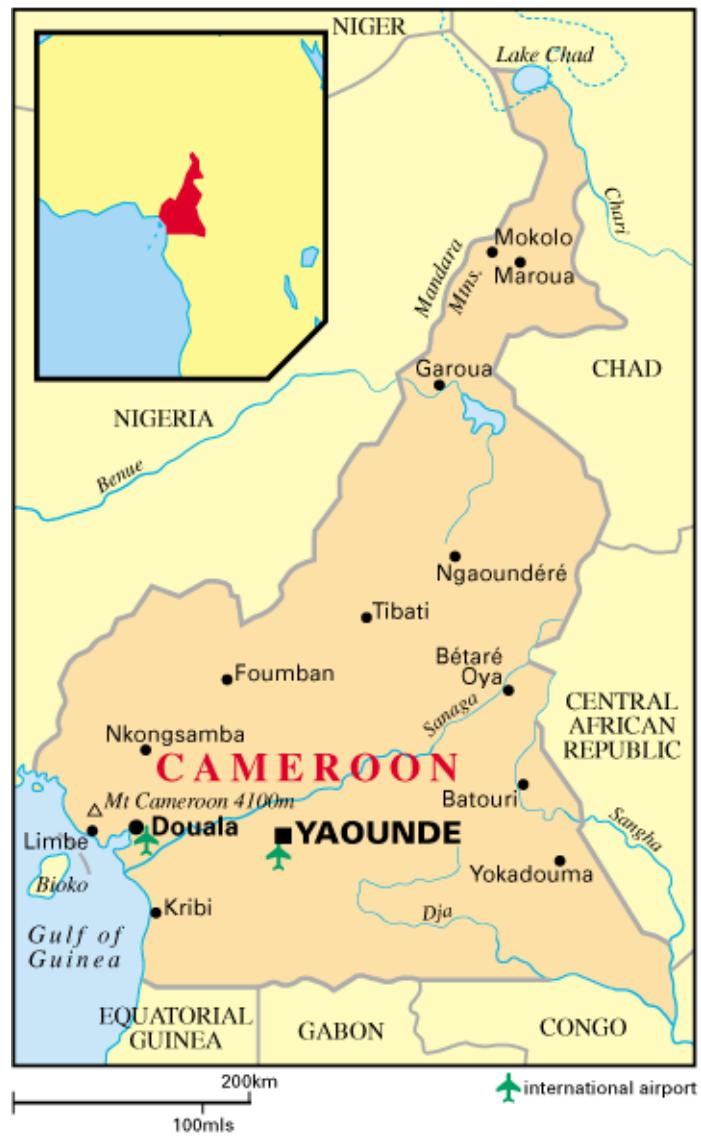

Passports

Passport valid for a minimum of six months required by all nationals referred to in chart above.

Visas

Required by all nationals referred to in chart above except the following:

(a) those in transit continuing their journey on the first or same aircraft within 24 hours provided holding onward tickets and not leaving the airport.

Note: Nationals not referred to in the chart above are advised to contact the embassy to check visa requirements (see *Contact Addresses*).

Visa Note

Journalists require accreditation by the Department of the Ministry of Communication in Yaounde (available through the high commission in London) before they can apply for a visa.

Types of Visa and Cost

Tourist and *Business*: £59, US\$98 (one day to three months); £118, US\$196 (six months). All visas are for multiple-entries. Prices are subject to variation.

Validity

Tourist and *Business* visas are valid from one day up to six months.

Applications to:

Consulate (or consular section at embassy); see *Contact Addresses*. Visas are also available on arrival for countries where Cameroon has no diplomatic representation.

Working Days Required

Two if the application is delivered in person; several for postal applications.
