Passports

Passport valid for at least six months after departure required by all nationals referred to in the chart above.

Visas

Not required by all nationals referred to in the chart above for stays of up to 30 days; extensions are available from the salvadorean immigration department.

1. Nationals of Canada, Greece and the USA must buy a tourist card for US\$10, valid for 30 days, on entry.

Note: Nationals not referred to in the chart above are advised to contact the embassy to check visa requirements (see *Contact Addresses*).

Visa Note

All nationals referred to in the chart above will need to apply for a multiple-entry visa in advance, if stay exceeds 30 days.
